

Autonomy Webinar – September 2011

Late last month, Autonomy held a Q&A webinar to review the latest releases of Teleform and Advanced Process Automation, as well as to discuss their near-term development.

Teleform

- Allows auto-redaction of a specific zone.
- Has moved to a more centralized monitoring model. All workstation errors now appear in Teleform Monitor.
- “Age” column is now available in the Batch Management view of Verifier, allowing the oldest batches to be identified. (Click on “Options” to add/remove columns)
- With regards to 2D barcodes, they are focusing on the PDF417-2D barcode; specifically enhancing the recognition of 39 and 128 barcodes.
- Autonomy is seeing a reluctance by Microsoft on the use/deployment of VBA, which caused a change to Visual Studio... which changed too.
 - To accommodate, a new COM API was developed for customization which enables VB.NET and C#. The new API supports current Teleform entry points.
 - VBA is supported for existing customers.
- Starting on 10.5.2, customers will have to request a new license key. (Infotek will handle this)
- Beginning with v10.6, they hope to move to Unicode.
- They have addressed the Window7 UAC issues- you will no longer have to be a local admin to install workstation components.

Advanced Process Automation

- Several customers wanted the ability to develop their HTML forms in open-source (such as Eclipse) and integrate that with APA. It now allows dynamic forms and will pass data from your third party form (such as a web form) directly to APA.
- Business Activity Monitoring (BAM) is now called “Analytics” and is a thin client. It used to be a tree item in the LiquidOffice Management Console.
- Alerts and Milestones have been canned and available within Process Studio.
- An iPad application is in the works (built around “WorkSite”), which should beta by the end of the year. I didn’t get the impression they are doing anything for Android.
