

Announcement Date: September 27, 2011

This announcement applies to: LiquidOffice administrators, form designers, and web users

Autonomy has made available, and Infotek has tested version 7.1 (Build 11116) of the Autonomy LiquidOffice product suite.

Note: Autonomy has rebranded LiquidOffice and it is now known as Autonomy Process Automation (APA).

The details of the Release Notes are attached. Infotek has only sanity tested this release for core functionality and has not performed full regression testing of all functions. Customers are encouraged to follow a testing and deployment plan appropriate for their environment.

The release is available thru the Autonomy ESD site, as well as thru Infotek. Contact us if you have any questions.

Infotek Testing Notes:

- Be sure to **stop all related services** and have an appropriate **maintenance window** before any upgrade.
- This is an “over the top” install on your current LiquidOffice environment. For a complete list of approved upgrade paths, please contact Autonomy or Infotek. For the LO Server install, simply run the supplied JAR file.
- Infotek’s test environment included one physical server (Windows 2008 R2). This also served at the SQL (2008 R2) and Tomcat (web) server for all LiquidOffice services.
- Certain functions of Form Designer 7.1 will not work with LO Server 7.0. It is suggested that you upgrade LO Server(s) and *then* Form Designer users.
- Existing “in process” forms and workflows appeared unaffected.
- Existing connect agents (used for lookups, exports, etc) functioned. No custom exports were tested.

Both the APA 7.1 server and Form Designer 7.1 are packaged as ZIP files.
